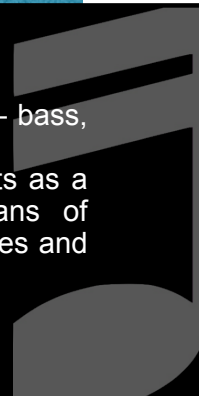
**What: The concert by the band ZAHLADA**

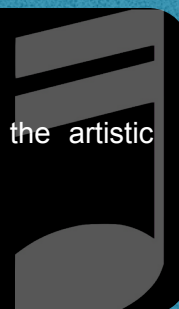
